

Un Dialogue Culturel: Assignment  
Unité 1.1: Les Introductions  
Français I

Imagine you and your partner(s) are in one of the following situations in the given country. Using the prompt given, create a dialogue that demonstrates the appropriate greetings and salutations according to what we have learned about greetings in the francophone world, then record your performance of this dialogue. Pay attention to how you should greet the person!

- I. **Choose who will be involved in your dialogue and in which scenario.** Make sure you make the appropriate greeting according to your country and the people involved.
  - A. Acquaintances who meet while walking along the Seine in Paris, France; if three people, introduce one.
  - B. M. Senghor, your professor, in the cafeteria at school in Sénégal; if three people, introduce one.
  - C. An elderly man and a young woman who meet at a town hall meeting in Haïti; if three people, introduce one.
  - D. Your new boss at a hospital in la République Démocratique du Congo; if three people, introduce one.
- II. **Include the following information in your dialogue:**
  - A. A verbal greeting as well as an appropriate greeting gesture (kiss, hug, handshake, etc.).
  - B. Continue the conversation by responding appropriately to the greeting and answer any questions your partner may ask you.
  - C. Be sure to greet your partner, introduce yourself, use an expression of politeness, and a salutation.
  - D. Each person in the dialogue should have about 4-5 lines to speak.
  - E. You DO NOT need to include any information outside of what is required. Limit yourself to vocabulary and phrases that you have already learned from the current unit.

- C. Overall, how do you feel you performed on this assignment?
- D. How could you have improved your performance on this assignment?
